Do you know

That following discussions between the National Trust and Scarborough Borough Council, it has been agreed that they will work in partnership to deliver the planned ground investigation works at Knipe Point.

Scarborough Borough Council has previously obtained funding from the Environment Agency for the works and the National Trust will now add funding with its own contributions. Now the funding is in place, it will ensure the works will go ahead as close to the intended timescale as possible.

The National Trust's Property Manager for the North York Moors and Coast has said the Trust believe that it is vitally important to use the ground investigation works to provide as much information as possible to understand the possible causes for landslides at Cayton Bay. By meeting the funding requirement needed to carry out the work, the Trust is building upon the time and investment it has already undertaken through the commissioning of ground reports. They are also continuing to conduct daily monitoring of the land at Knipe Point and Cayton Bay.

Following visits by contractors to the Knipe Point site earlier in the summer, all tenders for the ground investigation works have been received and the process of assessing the tenders is now underway.

Once the contractor has been selected, it is expected that work will start on site in October.

- Retaining Wall Masonry Cladding To Complete
- Bus Shelter Osgodby Lane to complete.
- Final layer of Tarmac surfacing to complete from Southern Tie-in to Northern Tie-in.
- Construct Tie-in to existing A165 & Mill Lane at Mill Lane Roundabout
- Construct Tie-in to existing A165 at South Cliff Roundabout.
- Complete erection of Road Signage.
- Complete installation of crash barrier.
- Complete verge fill & Topsoil.
- Fencing to Park & Ride Site to complete.
- Roof works to Park & Ride Buildings to complete
- M&E installation to complete.
- Cladding & Curtain Walling to Park & Ride Buildings to complete.
