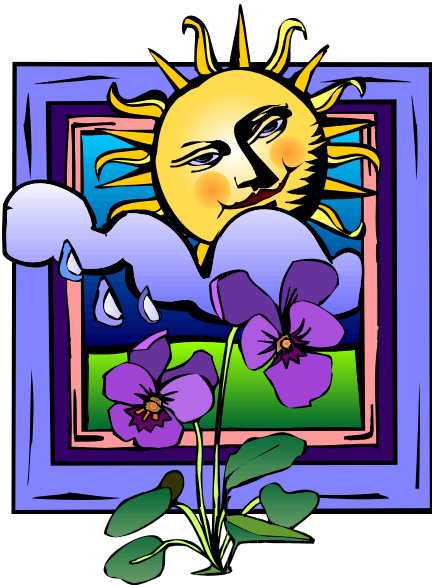
Currently there is a fleet of 12 mobile libraries and one Supermobile, which calls at over 800 hamlets, villages and towns in the area, usually with a number of different stops at each place.

This service is repeated on a three-weekly cycle, amounting to over 2500 scheduled visits per year.

Each mobile library carries around 2,500 items of stock, including books, videos, DVDs, and audio books. The stock is very varied and will satisfy most tastes, including those users who need information or those who are interested in local history.

This service is provided on a regular basis for Osgodby residents

- Sub-base, kerbs and tarmac between Osgodby Lane and Mill Lane to continue
- Retaining wall masonry cladding to continue
- Scaffold Support and concrete to St Leonard's Footbridge deck to complete
- Kerbs and tarmac surfacing to Park and Ride site to continue
- Roofwork to Park and Ride buildings to complete; Mechanical and Electrical installation to commence

- Earthworks to southern tie-in to complete
- Capping to southern tie-in to complete
- Sub-base, kerbs and tarmac to northern tie-in to complete (to back of footpath)
