Osgodby Lane Re-Surfacing

Osgodby Parish Council has heard there are plans to re-surface Osgodby Lane at the end of July this year. The Council have been pressing for this work to be done for some time and are delighted that action is now to be taken.

John Riby, Scarborough Borough Council's Head of Technical Services, has said he is very pleased to be able to confirm that £100,000 has been approved and allocated for the resurfacing work. He has indicated that the work is scheduled for a start the week beginning 20 July 2009 and will require a temporary road closure for three days whilst the work is ongoing.

The Borough Council will be liaising with local residents and the wider community in due course.

The Police report at each meeting of Osgodby Parish Council on their activities in the area for the preceding month.

At the last meeting they reported that the area had been regularly patrolled by our Local Community Officer PC1857 Susan Anderson and our local Community Support Officer PCSO4869 Caroline Richman supported by Response Officers, on a 24 hour 7 day a week basis, together with officers from the Road Policing Group.

The top police priorities for the area are as follows:

1. Youth related disorder including under age drinking and anti social behaviour and criminal damage.
2. Safer Roads, in particular speeding on Cayton Main Street – Station Road Cayton – Osgodby Lane at Osgodby and the A165 at Gristhorpe and Leberston.

In relation to the area priorities:

1. Officers continue to deal robustly with reported Anti Social Behaviour and ask the public to report matters at the time.
2. Officers from the Road Policing Group continue to patrol key areas under Operation SIREN and Operation ANVIL.

As well as dealing with everyday incidents officers dealt with the following:

During the week of 18th to 22nd May Officers assisted staff from Trading Standards with checks on possible rogue traders touting for work in the area. Residents are reminded not to engage door to door tradesmen.

There was one report of suspicious vehicle activity, one report of suspicious Persons activity, one report of anti-social behaviour and one request for a welfare visit.

Osgodby Parish Council greatly appreciate the work of the Police in general and congratulate both our Local Community Officer and our Local Community Support Officer who do an excellent job in maintaining Osgodby as a virtually crime-free area in which to live.
